# Colors

The Dexter logo uses a minimalistic color palette for consistent visual impact.

Whenever possible, the Dexter logo should be presented in full color.

The RGB .png file should be used only for digital use; for high-quality printing, use the PMS or CMYK .pdf file.

Never use any other color than those supplied. New colors need to be approved by the entire team.

The logo must be presented with the appropriate amount of clear space. Use this example as a guide.


Give all visual elements plenty of breathing room.

*Use .eps and .pdf files for use in printed materials like banners, brochures, and ad specialty items.*



*Use .png files for on-screen use like social posts, presentations, and website content and where a transparent background is needed. Use .jpg files when you require a very small file size.*
